We operate in over 200 locations – USO centers at or near military installations across the United States and throughout the world, including in combat zones, and even un-staffed USO service sites in places too dangerous for anyone but combat troops to occupy.

The USO is a family of volunteers, sustained by the charitable contributions of millions of generous Americans. We rely on supporters like you to fund the programs that make the biggest difference for our troops; we’re not a government agency. We are united in our commitment to support America’s service members by keeping them connected to the people, places and things they love. We do this through countless acts of caring, comfort, connection and support. Our work is America’s most powerful expression of gratitude to the men and women who secure our nation’s freedoms.

The USO at Denver International Airport opened on November 10, 2005; in 2018 we served over 132,000 visitors at that location, our location downtown at Denver’s Military Entrance Processing Station opened in July 2016, which served over 24,000 of our newest service members and their families; and we reached over 36,000 military personnel and their families through outreach events and activities throughout northern Colorado and southern Wyoming. In total, that was 193,156 connections with family, home and country.
