

## Look Wider International Travel Scholarship 2019/2020

In December 2013, the Rae Ann and Richard E. Dougherty Look Wider International Travel Fund was established to provide Colorado Girl Scouts with funding to fulfill their travel dreams while discovering the magic and power of the international sisterhood of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts.

Scholarships are awarded through a selection process of candidate(s) who satisfy the requirements and complete the application. Typical awards are between \$100 and \$500.

- Trip must be sponsored or endorsed by Girl Scouts of the USA or the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts. Trip must include international Girl Scouting/ Guiding in its agenda.
- The scholarship is for a girl or young woman member who is a G.I.R.L. (Go-getter, Innovator, Risk-Taker, Leader) and between the ages of 12 and 30 (aligned with WAGGGS guidelines) at the time travel is completed. Volunteers and staff members can also apply.
- The scholarship supports independent travel (Not intended to support travel with troop or family/friends.)
- The scholarship should support international travel, although a compelling domestic trip may be considered.
- The trip should provide meaningful, independent travel that fosters friendships between Girl Guides and Girl Scouts across the world.
- Recipient must meet all deadlines for her event so that deposit deadlines can be met.
- Applicant should share in her application what she has already achieved in Girl Scouting.
- Recipients **must** submit a short report, with at least three photos, upon return home.
- Applicant must be a member of Girl Scouts of the USA and a resident of Colorado.
